## “The Holy Spirit – The Outpouring”

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Holy Spirit - He is an advocate, a lawyer - He will go along beside you and tell you what to do

Holy Spirit is the author of protocols - He will author what it is you are supposed to do

He teaches us and goes along with us

It is a vision of our church to be an outpouring “Where the spirit of God is poured out upon ALL people”

You can be a part of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit - this is the reason you were created

These cups represent believers -



Acts 2:17 (NIV)- *In the last days, God says I will pour out my spirit on all people, Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions and your old men will dream dreams.*

Joel 2:28-32 (NIV) - *“And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions.*

<sup>29</sup>*Even on my servants, both men and women,*

*I will pour out my Spirit in those days.*

<sup>30</sup>*I will show wonders in the heavens  
and on the earth,  
blood and fire and billows of smoke.*

<sup>31</sup>*The sun will be turned to darkness  
and the moon to blood  
before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD.*

<sup>32</sup>*And everyone who calls  
on the name of the LORD will be saved;  
for on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem  
there will be deliverance,  
as the LORD has said,  
even among the survivors  
whom the LORD calls.*

**Zechariah 12:10 (NIV)** - *“And I will pour out on the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem a spirit of grace and supplication. They will look on me, the one they have pierced, and they will mourn for him as one mourns for an only child, and grieve bitterly for him as one grieves for a firstborn son.*

What are these 3 scriptures talking about? God will pour out His Spirit - The Outpouring

To understand The Outpouring, we have to understand Bible concepts:

1. First Blood, then Oil - The Tabernacle is a copy of Heavenly things on Earth. Moses sprinkled the items in The Tabernacle with blood. Why? Because whatever is sprinkled with the blood is made holy and pure to be used by God. Whatever the blood touches is made Holy and useful for God's purposes.

**Hebrews 9:11-12 (NIV)** - *But when Christ came as high priest of the good things that are now already here, he went through the greater and more perfect tabernacle that is not made with human hands, that is to say, is not a part of this creation. <sup>12</sup> He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, thus obtaining eternal redemption.*

So, God gave something to Moses to build on Earth that is represents what is in Heaven. Moses sprinkled everything with Blood. So they things in the Tabernacle were cleansed and made Holy to be used for God's purposes. Then everything was sprinkled with oil, which made it powerful.

Blood = Holy (Blood represents the blood Jesus shed for us on the cross - that makes us Holy)

Oil = Power (Oil represents that which is applied to something to make it Powerful)

The blood of Jesus touches us to make us Holy, but the Oil of the Holy Spirit comes over us to make us powerful. God doesn't want us to just be Holy, he wants us to be Powerful.

God doesn't want us to just be sanctified and set apart; he wants us to make an impact on the Earth.

**Hebrews 9:23 (NIV)** - *It was necessary, then, for the copies of the heavenly things to be purified with these sacrifices, but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these.*

Jesus went into the heavenly tabernacle and he sprinkled it with his blood (Hebrews 9:11-12, 23-24) obtaining eternal redemption. This act was necessary - the heavenly tabernacle had to be sanctified with the blood of Jesus. And now Jesus stands in the Shekinah Glory on the right hand of God, and he is waiting for you to make your appeal before the throne.

Jesus has got Blood that will make you Holy and Oil that will make you Powerful, and HE is on the throne. He is waiting on you to make your appeal before the heavenly throne, and when you come before the Father, Jesus is able to say - that's my child - (he or she) is one of mine to the Father. He intercedes for you.

Since God is God, the Father is saying there is no division in God, so since Jesus knows you, the Father knows you. There is one God, one Faith, and one Baptism. Amen!

So, now you are seated with Christ Jesus in heavenly places, which means "your cup" is already up here in the heavenly realm. Now you are in the presence of God, cleaned and purified by the blood.

If we are going to be useful, we cannot have the stain of sin in our lives - his blood is the purifier and cleanser of all sin.

What does it mean to be a part of the Outpouring of the Holy Spirit? Do you love being a "Blood Bought" vessel?

He takes his Blood to purify us and he takes his Oil to empower us. He doesn't want us to be just pure and clean, but He wants us to be powerful.

(Cups shown) are vessels that are blood bought - the world can see them - they are beauty. God wants to take his Spirit and pour it in to us - we are the vessels.



So, are we saying yes, I want ALL you got God - pour your Spirit into me?

No matter how it makes me look, I will take the oil

So as they become full, the oil begins to spill out of the vessels onto the Earth. - It begins to pour out and pour out upon the Earth.

God wants to pour out of his Spirit upon you, but it takes hunger and desire. This means I cannot have my own will - we have to yield to the outpouring. We are blood bought vessels that have the oil pouring out of them.

“I don’t want to settle just being ‘Blood Bought’ I want to have the ‘Anointing’ of the Spirit”

As the vessels begin to get filled, they begin to pour out and impact nations and shift atmospheres.

What am I? I am a blood bought vessel walking into Walmart (or wherever) but I want to be an oily vessel that touches every aisle that is overflowing with the oil of the Spirit and changing the atmosphere - by pouring out the Glory of God.

God wants to pour out of his Spirit upon you, but it takes Hunger and Desire. It means that I cannot have my own will. When we stop yielding, and setup and wall between us and the oil, we are still a blood bought vessel that is shiny and pretty, but God wants those vessels filled with oil so he can use them to change nations.

The outpouring of the Holy Spirit is an experience that has been felt by 600 Million + people.

**Ephesians 5:18 (AMP)** - *And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery; but ever be filled and stimulated with the [Holy] Spirit.*

I am eternally secure in the hands of Jesus. Holy Spirit will catch up to you if you backslide.

You get the overflowing of that oil of the Holy Spirit regularly, daily. It is a constant experience, but you got to stay under that outpouring.

What does that look like?

**Acts 2:4 (AMP)** - *And they were all filled (diffused throughout their souls) with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other (different, foreign) languages (tongues), as the Spirit kept giving them clear and loud expression [in each tongue in appropriate words].*

The Overflow of the Holy Spirit = Speaking in tongues

**Acts 2:12 (AMP)** - *And all were beside themselves with amazement and were puzzled and bewildered, saying one to another, what can this mean?*

What we see in an Outpouring of the Holy Spirit

1. People Speaking in Tongues
2. People asking questions

“If you go to church and you do not have a question about anything that is happening, chances are The Outpouring is not occurring”

The outpouring means that crowds assemble and ask questions. You sometimes have got to ask questions.

**Acts 2:14-16 (NIV)** - *Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice and addressed the crowd: “Fellow Jews and all of you who live in Jerusalem, let me explain this to you; listen carefully to what I say. <sup>15</sup> These people are not drunk, as you suppose. It’s only nine in the morning! <sup>16</sup> No, this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel:*

Peter was a ‘cussing fisherman’ (full of mistakes), and Peter addressed the crowd to explain things.

The Outpouring of the Holy Spirit will take a “cussing fisherman” and have them address a crowd like a revelatory preacher

“There is something about revelation knowledge that when the Oil of the Spirit is being poured out, that imperfect people can be used perfectly by a perfect God.”

**Acts 2:37-41 (NIV)** - *When the people heard this, they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and the other apostles, “Brothers, what shall we do?”*

<sup>38</sup> *Peter replied, “Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. <sup>39</sup> The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off—for all whom the Lord our God will call.”*

<sup>40</sup> *With many other words he warned them; and he pleaded with them, “Save yourselves from this corrupt generation.” <sup>41</sup> Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day.*

When the Outpouring begins to be poured out Repentance and the Born Again Experience begins to take place.

**Acts 2:42-47 (NIV)** - *They devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. <sup>43</sup> Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. <sup>44</sup> All the believers were together and had everything in common. <sup>45</sup> They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. <sup>46</sup> Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and*

*ate together with glad and sincere hearts*, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

When the Outpouring happens ....

V 42 -There is devotion to the Word of God. When you get under the Holy Spirit, you are going to love your Bible in a new dimension. There is a new devotion to prayer and a new devotion to fellowship.

V 43 - Miracles will begin to take place

V 44 - 46- We are ready to sacrifice for one another

V47 - There will be a constant stream of people added to the faith.
